COURSE DESCRIPTION

Bible II provides a survey of the 27 books of the New Testament. This includes authorship, dates and places of writing, key themes, identification of important Biblical figures. Christian service and the application of Biblical truth to the life of the present-day Christian are also emphasized.

COURSE SCOPE AND SEQUENCE

Background 2 Week

Key Concepts: Old Testament Overview – Creation, Fall, Covenants, Law and Prophets. Revelation, Formation of the Canon, and Attributes of Scripture.

Intertestamental Period 1 Week

Key Concepts: Temple and Synagogue Worship. Alexander the Great, Hellenization, Ptolemaic and Seleucid Empires, Antiochus Epiphanes and Maccabean Revolt.

The Ministry of Christ After His Ascension 2 Weeks
